The Zinggia Art Scholarship was started by two artists to help students further their education in the visual arts field. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students whose creativity, inventiveness, and desire for foil-wrapped burrito goodness knows no limits.

Eligibility requirements:

- High school senior
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Major career interest: Arts (general, painting, illustration, design, photography, printmaking, sculpture, video, etc.)
- Resident of the State of Ohio and United States citizen

Qualified institutions & level of study:

- Award may be used for full-time study in the United States (school of choice does not need to be in Ohio)

Award may be used at:

- Art School
- Two-year college or technical school
- Four-year college

Application requirements:

- Current high school transcript with GPA
- Signed letter of recommendation from teacher or guidance counselor (preferably Art Teacher)

NOTE: If your school's policy requires them to directly mail transcripts or letters of recommendations on your behalf, please make note on your application that those items will be mailed separate from your application.

Other application requirements:

- Provide artwork samples: Submit images of five of your best pieces of artwork (no more or less) that have been created by you in the last four years. Samples can be provided on CD or THUMB DRIVE in JPEG, PDF, or Video format, or as photographs or printouts. You may provide multiple images of one piece (close-ups, different angles, etc). Please write your name on the CD & make sure it works before mailing. We will NOT notify you if your CD is unreadable.
- Digital file names or printed samples must be labeled and named according to the list in Section D on page 2 of the application. (Example: "Sample 1", "Sample 2", etc). A short description of each artwork is required.
- Digital images should be high resolution (minimum 1200 pixels).
- Photographs or printouts should be no larger than 8.5" x 11".
- All submissions are non-returnable, so do not send original pieces or anything that you don't want returned.
- Artwork submitted must be original works produced by the applicant alone.

Additional information:

- Incomplete applications will not be considered. Check application for all requirements before submitting.
- Emailed applications or teacher recommendations will NOT be accepted.
- Type or print legibly. Proofread and spell check because we take grammar super seriously!
- Scholarship winner must be accepted as a full time student at a college for the 2017-2018 academic year. Scholarship money is only awarded for an Arts-based program. Award will be paid to the winner once proof of enrollment at an academic school for post-secondary studies has been verified. Award can be used for tuition or supplies.
